On the first Thursday of every month, a truck comes to Monticello with 30,000 lbs. of food that is given away!!!

That's right! Second Harvest Heartland is the upper Midwest's largest hunger relief organization that works in cooperation with local agencies to alleviate hunger in their 59 county service area. In 2006 Second Harvest launched a pilot program that brought surplus food and household commodities to families that needed a helping hand. The food distributed through this program is intended to serve as a supplemental program meeting some of the needs in addition to the ones that the local food shelves are addressing.

For a monthly payment of only \$475.00, a fully loaded semi truck with approximately 30,000 lbs of food and other needed items such as diapers, laundry detergent, or hygiene products will continue to arrive in Monticello on a monthly basis!

On average, 500 families are served at the Monticello distribution site. Each family receives one to two laundry baskets full of groceries for FREE and that's made possible for only one dollar per family!
